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### II.1.5) Short description of the contract or purchase(s)

The service covered by this call for tender is an engineering study regarding the procedures and the facilities needed for the Cold Test and a Coil Insertion of the Toroidal Field (TF) Winding Packs (WP) of the Toroidal Field Coils of the ITER magnet system.

In total 19 TF coils will be produced, of which 10 will produced in Europe and 9 in Japan.

The TF coils are "D" shaped coils, composed of a WP inserted inside a stainless steel coil case. The coils case is composed of 4 shelves welded to each other around the WP.

The Winding Packs are produced and shipped to the cold test and coil insertion facility. A single supplier will be in charge of both cold tests and coils insertion and will have to carry out an acceptance test of the WP during the incoming inspection.

The scope of supply is a detailed engineering study of the cold test and coil insertion procedures and required facilities of the ITER TF coils.

The supply will include:

- definition of the buildings and their layout to carry out the operations;
- definition of the lifting and handling equipment to carry out the different operations;
- definition of the equipments and procedures required for the acceptance tests (incoming tests of winding packs and case subsections);
- definition of the equipments and procedures required for cold test;
- definition of the equipments and procedures required for coil case insertion;
- A lay-out of the facilities, based on the work flow and the on the required production rates, to carry out cold tests, coils insertion and case welding (2 production options);
- A complete cost and schedule estimations.

The work shall be carried out in conformity with the quality and technical requirements as set out in Quality Management Specifications (Annex A) and Technical Specifications (Annex B).

This procurement procedure shall be open on equal terms to tenderers that are nationals of a Member of Fusion for Energy or are established in the territory of a Member of Fusion for Energy (i.e. Member States of the European Union and Switzerland).

##### EXCLUSION CRITERIA

Tenderers shall be excluded from participation in the present procurement procedure if:

- a) they are bankrupt or being wound up, are having their affairs administered by the courts, have entered into an arrangement with creditors, have suspended business activities, are the subject of proceedings concerning those matters, or are in any analogous situation arising from a similar procedure provided for in national legislation or regulations;
- b) they have been convicted of an offence concerning their professional conduct by a judgement which has the force of res judicata;
- c) they have been guilty of grave professional misconduct proven by any means which the Joint Undertaking can justify;
- d) they have not fulfilled obligations relating to the payment of social security contributions or the payment of taxes in accordance with the legal provisions of the country in which they are established or with those of the country of the Joint Undertaking or those of the country where the contract is to be performed;
- e) they have been the subject of a judgement which has the force of res judicata for fraud, corruption, involvement in a criminal organisation or any other illegal activity detrimental to the Joint Undertaking's or the Communities financial interests;
- f) they are currently subject to an administrative penalty imposed by the Community institutions as referred to in the Financial Regulation applicable to the budget of the European communities.

Tenderers shall be excluded from the award of the contract if during the present procurement procedure:

- g) they are subject to a conflict of interest
- h) they are guilty of misrepresentation in supplying the information required by the Joint Undertaking as a condition of participation in the contract procedure or fail to supply this information.

NB: In their tenders, tenderers shall provide a declaration on their honour, duly signed and dated, stating that they are not in one of the situations listed above, based on the Specimen in Annex 3. Only the tenderer to whom the contract is to be awarded shall provide the documents mentioned below before signature of the contract and within the deadline given by Fusion for Energy.

The following documents will be accepted as proof that the tenderer is not in any of the situations mentioned in points a), b), c) ,d), e), f):

- i) for a), b) and e), the production of a recent extract from the judicial record or, failing that, an equivalent document recently issued by a judicial or administrative authority in the country of origin or provenance, showing that those requirements are satisfied;
- ii) in the case mentioned in d), a recent certificate issued by the competent authority of the Member State concerned.

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Where the document or certificate referred to above is not issued in the country concerned it may be replaced by a sworn or, failing that, a solemn statement made by the interested party before a judicial or administrative authority, a notary or a qualified professional body in its country of origin or provenance;

iii) in the cases mentioned in c) and f), the tenderer will have to provide a sworn or, failing that, a solemn statement made by the interested party before a judicial or administrative authority, a notary or a qualified professional body in its country of origin or provenance.

Depending on the national legislation of the country in which the tenderer is established, the documents referred to above shall relate to legal persons and/or natural persons including company directors or any person with powers of representation, decision-making or control in relation to the tenderer.

Fusion for Energy may waive the obligation of the winning tenderer to submit this evidence if it has already been submitted to Fusion for Energy for the purposes of another procurement procedure and provided that the documents are not more than one year old starting from their issuing date and that they are still valid.

The following information and documents shall be provided in the tender:

a) Full name of the entity, legal status, registration number, VAT number, address, telephone and fax numbers, the name of the contact person responsible for the tender as well as the name of the legal representative of the entity, as signatory of the contract (Annex 5 – Identification form).

The tenderer must have adequate financial and economic capacity to perform the contract within the indicated timeframe. To this end, the following documents shall be provided by the tenderer, and by all members of the grouping, in their answer:

- A statement of the candidate's overall turnover for the last three financial years for which accounts have been closed.

- The presentation of Balance Sheets and Profit and Loss account for the last three years for which accounts have been closed.

Balance Sheets and Profit and Loss account shall be presented both in the official format of the tenderer and in the template provided by Fusion for Energy in Annex 10 of the Tender Specifications (Simplified Balance Sheets and Profit & Loss Account Form). For the assessment of the economic and financial capacity, the following ratios/noteworthy values and threshold will be considered (for these calculations the average of each parameter over the last three financial years according information provided in Annex 10 will be considered):

a) Minimum viability standards.

• Liquidity:

- Ratio: (Current assets – stocks – debtors due after one year) / Short term debt (bank and non-bank)

- The evaluation will be considered negative if ratio < 0.4.

• Solvency:

- Ratio: Total debt / (Capital and reserves – 50% of intangible fixed assets)

- The evaluation will be considered negative if ratio > 7 or < 0.

• Profitability.

- Ratio: Gross Operating Profit / Turnover

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- The evaluation will be considered negative if ratio < 0.05

With regard to joint tenders (groupings) the minimum viability standards will be assessed individually in relation to each member of the grouping. If a grouping member fails to meet the selection criteria, the whole grouping shall be rejected.

b) Noteworthy values to be achieved.

• Turnover.

- Noteworthy value: Average overall turnover.

- Evaluation: Negative if noteworthy value < 2,500,000 €.

• Cashflow:

- Noteworthy value: (Net Result + Depreciation and value adjustments on non financial assets - Extraordinary incomes + Extraordinary charges)

- Evaluation : Negative if noteworthy value < 1.000,000 €

With regard to joint tenders (groupings) the noteworthy values will be assessed globally (all members of the grouping together).

In relation with both a) and b):

(i) The economic and financial capacity will be considered adequate for performance of the contract if at least two of the three minimum viability standards (liquidity, solvency, profitability) are considered positively and at least one of the two noteworthy values (turnover, cashflow) are considered positively.

(ii) If, for some exceptional reason which Fusion for Energy considers justified, the tenderer is unable to provide the references requested above, its economic and financial capacity may be proved by any other means which the Joint Undertaking considers appropriate.

(iii) An economic operator may, where appropriate, rely on the capacities of other entities including subcontractors, regardless of the legal nature of the links which it has with them. It must in that case prove to the Joint Undertaking that it will have at its disposal the resources necessary for performance of the contract, for example by producing an Undertaking on the part of those entities to place those resources at its disposal. Templates for this purpose are provided in Annex 11 and 12 of the Tender Specifications.

- (i) Superconducting Magnet Technology.
- (ii) Assembly of large components (more than 5 tons).
- (iii) Welding of stainless steel components with complex geometry (from 1G to 5G positions).
- (iv) Definition, design and operation of Cold tests and large cryogenic facilities (down to about 5 K and with more than 0.5 kW cooling power).
- (v) Schedule, resources and cost estimation of facilities and activities corresponding to a financial value larger than 1 millions €. per year.

As evidence of the experience under point a), the tenderer shall submit:

- A list of projects where each of the technical competences below is applied. The tender shall provide a brief description of the activities carried out within the project and duration of the contract performance and budget; and
- Any other relevant piece of evidence capable of supporting experience in the technical competences above.

In order to consider the 5 years of experience for each technical competence above it will be taken in consideration the total duration of the projects listed by the tenderers.

b) The organisational chart in terms of manpower proposed for the execution of the contract and their detailed educational and professional qualification.

The organisation chart shall at least include :

- One project manager.
- One responsible for the cryogenic analysis.
- One responsible for the schedule, costs and resource estimation.
- One responsible for the definition of the manufacturing aspects and workflow.

Any individual professional cannot cover more than 2 of these positions.

As evidence of the capabilities under point b the tenderer shall submit:

- (i) The organisational chart for this project; and
- (ii) Detailed education and professional background of the staff in the organisational chart with clearly indication of previous relevant projects where they have participated. The staff covering the mandatory positions above should have at least 10 years of experience in their field. The other staff indicated in

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the organisation chart should have at least 5 years of experience in their field.

In case of joint tenders (groupings) the technical and professional capacity will be assessed in relation to the combined capacities of all members of the grouping, as a whole.

An economic operator may, where appropriate, rely on the capacities of other entities including subcontractors, regardless of the legal nature of the links which it has with them. It shall in that case prove to Fusion for Energy that it will have at its disposal the resources necessary for performance of the contract, for example by producing an undertaking on the part of those entities to place those resources at its disposal. Templates for this purpose are provided in Annex 11 and 12 of the Tender Specifications. The reliance upon other entities including subcontractors shall be without prejudice to the question of the tenderers liability.
